'Check it Out' was a TV series made by Tyne Tees Television between 1979 and 1982. The episode we will see is one made in 1979 which focuses on homosexuality and features a day in the life of a young gay couple in Newcastle in the late 1970s.

'Out on Tuesday' was a ground breaking series shown by Channel 4, featuring North East people talking about how women and men interact on the gay scene.

'Greta's Party' - A special programme shown by Tyne Tees in 2000 to celebrate the 50th birthday of one of Newcastle's best known drag artistes - Greta La More.
